Our beloved Adolph went to be with the Lord on Friday, April 16, 2021 at the age of 88. Born in Wyco, West Virginia on July 10, 1932, Adolph will be forever missed by so many. He was a loving husband, father, grandfather, great-grandfather, and friend. He is preceded in death by his wife, Peggy; his parents, Rudolph and Mary Pedri; sisters, Rena Wilcox, Emma Pedri, and Josephina Pedri; and a daughter-in-law, Tammy Pedri.
