September 21, 1933 - February 17, 2010

Robert Clair "Bob" Byars, Sr., 76, of Garwood, passed away Wednesday, Feb. 17, 2010 at Princeton Community Hospital following a long illness. Born September 21, 1933 at Itmann, he was the son of the late Pink Byars, Jr. and Cora Mae Tolliver Byars. Robert was raised on Bud Mountain and then at the age of eighteen he joined the US Marine Corps and served from April 1951 until April 1954, having served during the Korean Conflict. During his working career, Bob was a retired coal miner and former truck driver, which he really loved to do. He was also a member of UMWA. He was the oldest living member of the Herndon Freewill Baptist Church. In addition to his parents, he was also preceded in death by a brother, Mickey Byars; several other infant brothers and sisters; a son-in-law, Bennie Raye; and a nephew, Dale Byars.
